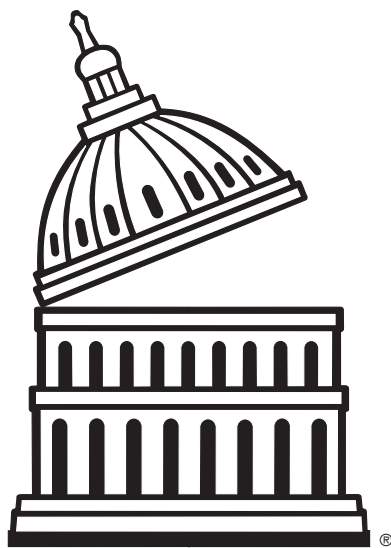

4 The last names of individuals listed in the Foreign Nations section appear in capital letters for proper identification.

A listing may contain date registered information. This represents the date on which each diplomat or consular officer is officially recognized by the United States and assumes his/her duties. The date determines the order of precedence for officers within their respective title categories.

► **Intergovernmental Organizations Section**

The Intergovernmental Organizations section lists the U.S. offices of such organizations as the United Nations and the European Union. Each listing begins with the name of the organization, headquarters address, communication information and a brief description of its purpose. The U.S. offices are listed with their address, communications information, and top executives. Any of the following information may be listed for each individual: (a) address, if different from the main address (b) telephone and facsimile numbers and e-mail address (c) educational background and affiliations. The last names of individuals listed in this section appear in capital letters for proper identification.

► **Foreign Press Section**

The Foreign Press section lists the U.S. bureaus and other offices of the foreign press. Each listing includes the description, address, telephone and facsimile numbers, and key U.S. bureau personnel.

► **Law Firms Section**

The Law Firms section lists foreign law firms with offices located in the U.S. Each listing begins with the foreign law firm name, headquarters address, communication information, a brief practice description including practice areas, and the managing partner. The U.S. Representatives heading introduces the firm's main U.S. offices with their resident partners and associates. Any of the following information may be listed for each individual: (a) address, if different from the main address (b) telephone and facsimile numbers and e-mail address (c) educational background.

Indexes

To assist readers in locating specific information quickly and easily, the *Foreign Representatives in the U.S. Yellow Book* contains four indexes. Main entries in all indexes, with the exception of the Name Index, appear in italics.

► **Industry Index**

Lists corporations, financial institutions, foreign press outlets, and law firms according to their principal fields of operation. Each organization and its U.S. representatives can appear in as many subject categories as is appropriate.

► **Geographical Index**

Lists all U.S. subsidiaries and representative offices alphabetically by state and within each state by city. Companies and subsidiaries based in U.S. territories and non-U.S. countries are also listed alphabetically by territory or country, and by city within each territory or country.

► **Name Index**

Lists all individuals who appear in the book.

► **Organization Index**

Lists all main entries, their U.S. representatives, and their consultants.
